ANNEX 2 – Role of Expert Reviewers

Key partners in the CVM3 project will take part in the Collaborating Stakeholders Review process with varied review responsibilities, including the Advisory Panel, Expert Reviewers and Outreach Partners.

Participants in the review process will represent a range of relevant institutions (through geographic, thematic, and other relevant differentiations), but in particular, where possible, organizations with an inter-disciplinary focus (i.e., dealing with multiple social, economic or development and environmental issues) should be involved in addition to specialised climate change institutions. The Research Consortium and Science Clusters themselves, together with the third-party external review entity (and subsequently also academic journal peer review), hold responsibility for guaranteeing the technical accuracy and scientific validity of the underlying work. The collaborating stakeholder review aims to engage and reflect the opinions of stakeholders that are influential in shaping national and regional, if not also global, policies and agenda relevant to climate change. The value of the Review is more to ensure that the information generated is interpreted, presented, and conveyed as effectively as possible for the purpose of subsequent uptake by priority Users and other important policy groups.

Expert Reviewers, appointed by CVF/V20/GCA and nominated by Regional Research Partners are responsible for reviewing a draft report prior to publication, with comments valid for all aspects of the report in technical and communication terms. Expert reviewers represent the principal source of participation for the internal review process of the Monitor. (Review competency: all respects). A template will be provided by the Research Consortium to the Expert Reviewers to support sharing feedback.
