# The 3<sup>rd</sup> Workshop under the Glasgow-Sharm el-Sheikh Work Programme on the Global Goal on Adaptation

### 17-18 October 2022

I am pleased to provide updated information to United Nations Secretariat units and bodies, specialized agencies and related organizations and intergovernmental organizations admitted as observers by the Conference of the Parties regarding the third workshop under the Glasgow-Sharm el-Sheikh work programme on the Global Goal on Adaptation which will take place from 17 to 18 October 2022 in Cairo, Arab Republic of Egypt.

The workshop will be hosted by the Government of Egypt and will be organized by the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change in collaboration with the United Nations Office in Egypt and will be held in a hybrid format.

Pursuant to decision 7/CMA.3, Parties to the Paris Agreement agreed on the modalities and procedures of the work programme and decided that eight workshops would be conducted during 2022 and 2023, which will be open to attendance by admitted observer organizations.

To register for the workshop, interested United Nations organizations and admitted observer intergovernmental organizations should email their request to <a href="mailto:gga@unfccc.int">gga@unfccc.int</a>. The deadline for registration as an observer for the workshop is **Wednesday**, 5 October 2022. In view of the need to confirm the arrangements for the workshop as early as possible, registrations received after this date may not be processed. For those wishing to follow the workshop without active participation, it will be broadcast live on YouTube.

Please note that in-person participants are responsible for making their own visa, medical insurance and hotel arrangements as well as checking the entry requirements and regulations for Egypt (including vaccination, testing, digital entry information, possible quarantine, etc.).
