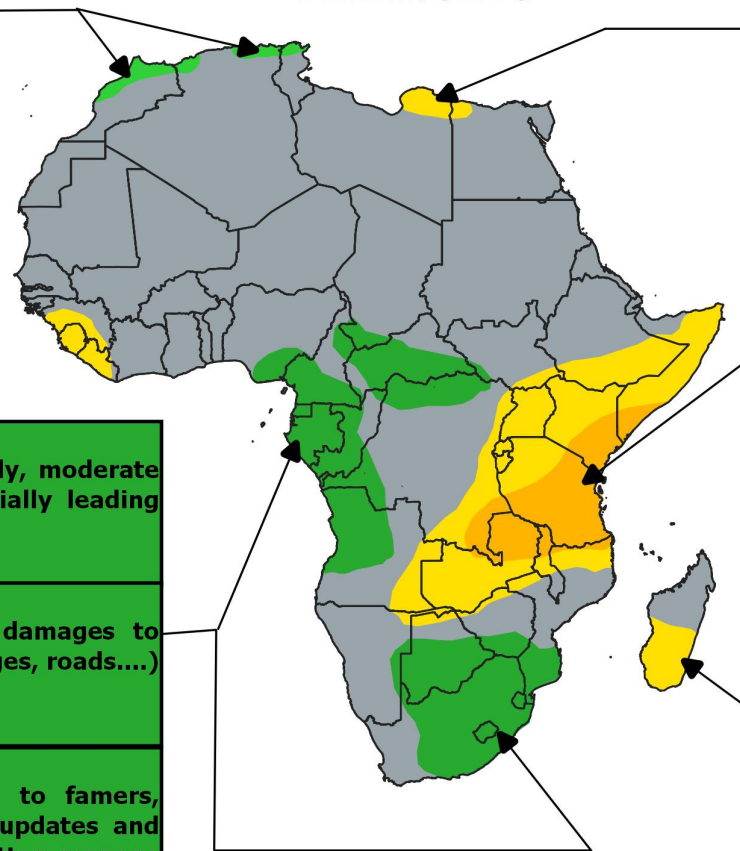


**BREIF FOR POLICY AND DECISION MAKERS ON EXPECTED
SIGNIFICANT WEATHER AND CLIMATE EVENTS
FROM SEPTEMBER TO DECEMBER 2020: A CONTRIBUTION TO
IMPACTS BASED FORECAST AND FORECAST BASED PLANNING/
FINANCING**



HAZARDS
Above average precipitation very likely, moderate to heavy precipitation events potentially leading the floods, landslides and soil erosion.

POTENTIALS IMPACTS
Outbreak of water borne diseases, damages to infrastructures (dams, reservoirs, bridges, roads....)

MEASURES
Porvides agro meteorolglal advices to famers, prepare for heavy rains and floods, updates and implement the contingency plans, better manage water in reservoirs and dams

HAZARDS
Below average precipitation very likely, delay onset and seasonal precipitation deficits. Irregular distribution of precipitation during the season and drought of at least moderate intensity very likely.

POTENTIALS IMPACTS
Water shortage, decrease in crop yields, degradation of pasture and rise in foods prices

MEASURES
Update and implement drought management plans, prioritize planting in low land areas, promote drought resistant crops, harvest rainfall to mitigate water shortage
